I look forward to Meghan's future transitions to Miss Nicole's and then Miss Sue's classes as well. Although none of my three children are currently in the classes lead by these wonderful ladies, we see and talk to them every time we are picking up and dropping off our children.

When I ask my 3-year-old who his best friends at school are, Miss Missy and Miss Susan always top the list. Sean can really be quite a handful, particularly at the morning drop-off, and I have to sincerely thank every teacher in the school- because at some point they ALL have assisted me in orchestrating the transition, which can be quite a challenge!

We were also thrilled in the beginning of the year when we found out that Miss Chantal was making the transition from assistant to teacher! She is a fantastic person and I hope she finds this experience as rewarding as we find her guidance to be for our Rainbow! I really think Bryan has greatly benefited from the combination of Miss Chantal, Miss Nina, and Mr. Marques during his afternoons at A Child's World.

And now that "sometime soon" has arrived! We are hoping that all will go as planned, and we will see Bryan's graduation ceremony in the brand new building!

As exciting as it is to have the new facility on the way, I just want to point out that we recognize that it is not really the building that matters at all...it's the wonderful people inside of it that make all the difference in the lives of the children who attend A Child's World...*and* their parents.
