

Dear Parents,

A Child's World is happy to welcome you to our school. Our goal is to provide quality educational and child care programming for every child. Enclosed are instructions for the first day of school in addition to a questionnaire for the staff to become better acquainted with your child. Please bring all items listed below on the beginning day.

ITEMS APPROPRIATE FOR EACH AGE GROUP

INFANTS/BABIES

- 2 complete changes of clothing – one to remain in school, the second may be taken home each day. Include undershirts and socks with the changes in a labeled shoe box.
- Diapers and wipes (a package/container of each)
- 2 Pack N Play sheets (Doylestown facility)
- 2 Portable crib sheets (Newtown/Langhorne facilities)
- all necessary food requirements including:
 1. bottles filled with formula or milk
 2. special foods or drinks
 3. written instructions for each meal and time schedule
- Bag with child's individual daily needs, i.e., pacifier, cloth diaper or burp cloth, bib, one of the two clothing changes.
- Box of tissues

TODDLERS/2-YEAR OLD

- 2 complete changes of clothing – one to remain in school, the second may be taken home each day. Include undershirts and socks with the changes in a labeled shoe box.
- Diapers and wipes (package/container of each)
- A Child's World Nap Mat and pillowcase or laundry bag for storage
- Smock (can be a shirt with cut off sleeves)
- Sippy cup, juice box
- Bagged lunch each day if staying full day for lunch
- Box of tissues
- School bag with one of the two clothing changes.

3, PRE-K AND KINDERGARTEN

- Complete change of clothing (please include undergarments and socks)
- Smock (can be a shirt with cut off sleeves)
- A Child's World Nap Mat and pillowcase or laundry bag for storage (excluding Kindergarten)
- Box of tissues
- Regular size school bag
- Bagged lunch if staying full day, extended care lunch or kindergarten enrichment.

LABEL ALL ITEMS

We look forward to seeing you. Your child's teacher will contact you to become better acquainted before the first day of school. Parent/teacher conferences are scheduled twice a year, in January and at the end of the school year.
